



Pursuant to **Arizona Revised Statutes § 38-431.02**, notice is hereby given to the members of the Apache Junction Sewer District Board of Directors and to the general public that the Apache Junction Sewer District (the “**District**”) will hold a Regular Meeting open to the public on Tuesday, May 21, 2024 at 8:00 AM in the District Board Room, 5661 S. Ironwood Drive, Apache Junction, Arizona to discuss and possibly take legal action on the following agenda items. Members of the District’s Board of Directors may attend either in person or by telephone.

1. Call to Order.
2. Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance.
3. Discussion of the District’s proposed budget and proposed rates, fees and charges for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024. Request for adoption of Resolution No. 24-02 (a) establishing the District’s proposed rates, fees and charges applicable beginning July 1, 2024; (b) establishing the District’s proposed budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024; (c) authorizing notifying the Mayor and Council of the City of Apache Junction of the proposed rates, fees and charges and the proposed budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024; and (d) establishing a date, time and place for a public hearing on the District’s adoption of its (i) rates, fees and charges applicable beginning July 1, 2024, and (ii) the District’s final budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024.
4. Approval of the Minutes of the April 23, 2024 Regular Meeting and Work Session.
5. Monthly Disclosure Report on Operations for April 2024.
6. Monthly Project Status Report for April 2024.
7. Discussion and update of the Water Reclamation Facility (WRF) Expansion and action as determined.
8. District Manager’s Report for April 2024.
9. Discussion of the District’s Harassment Prevention Training.
10. Discussion of election of Board Officers and action as determined.
11. Call to the public. The Board will neither discuss nor take legal action on a matter raised during the call to the public but may refer the matter to the District staff for review or direct the matter to be put on a future agenda. Members of the Board may respond to matters raised as permitted by Arizona Revised Statutes § 38-431.01.I.
12. Discussion of the District’s legal representation and action as determined. The Board will first consider this matter in an executive session that will not be open to the public, pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes Ann. § 38-431.03.A.4.

At the conclusion of the Executive Session the Board may reconvene the Regular Meeting to discuss and take action, if any is proposed, regarding matters discussed in the Executive Session.

13. Direction from the Board of Directors to staff regarding items to place on the next Regular Board Meeting agenda.
14. Adjournment

EXECUTIVE SESSION:

If authorized by a majority vote of the members of the District’s Board of Directors attending the Regular Meeting, an executive session, for the purpose of obtaining advice from legal counsel on any matter listed on the agenda, will be held immediately following the vote pursuant to Ariz. Rev. Stat. Ann. § 38-431.03.A.3. The Regular Meeting of the District’s Board of Directors will be temporarily recessed while the District’s Board of Directors retires to an executive session that will not be open to the public. At the conclusion of the executive session, the Board may reconvene the Regular Meeting to consider and decide these matters during a public meeting or defer the decision to a later date.
