



Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the Apache Junction Sewer District Board of Directors and to the general public that the Apache Junction Sewer District (the “District”) will hold a Regular Meeting open to the public on Tuesday, September 23, 2025 at 8:00 AM in the District Board Room, 5661 S. Ironwood Drive, Apache Junction, Arizona to discuss and possibly take legal action on the following agenda items. Members of the District’s Board of Directors may attend either in person or by telephone.

1. Call to Order.
2. Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance.
3. Discussion and review of the 90% to 100% cost reconciliation for the Water Reclamation Facility (WRF) Expansion and action as determined.
4. Approval of the Minutes of the August 26, 2025 Regular Meeting.

6. Monthly Project Status Report for August 2025.
7. Discussion and update of the WRF Expansion and action as determined.
8. District Manager’s Report for August 2025.
9. Request for authorization and approval of the purchase and replacement of three return activated sludge (RAS) pumps at a cost not to exceed \$575,000 to be paid from the Capital and Replacement Fund.
10. Discussion and review of the District’s tax exempt status.
11. Call to the public. The Board will neither discuss nor take legal action on a matter raised during the call to the public but may refer the matter to the District staff for review or direct the matter to be put on a future agenda. Members of the Board may respond to matters raised as permitted by Arizona Revised Statutes § 38-431.01(I).
12. Request for authorization and approval to enter into an Indemnification Agreement between Apache Junction Sewer District and Archer Western Construction, LLC. The Board will first consider this matter in executive session that will not be open to the public pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes § 38-431.03(A)(4).
13. Discussion of the status of the District’s information technology contract and security plans, procedures, assessments, measures or systems relating to information technology. The Board will first consider this matter in executive session that will not be open to the public pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes § 38-431.03(A)(4) and (A)(9).
14. Direction from the Board of Directors to staff regarding items to place on the next Regular Board Meeting agenda.

EXECUTIVE SESSION:

If authorized by a majority vote of the members of the District's Board of Directors attending the regular meeting, an executive session, for the purpose of obtaining advice from legal counsel on any matter listed on the agenda, will be held immediately following the vote pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes § 38-431.03(A)(3). The Regular Meeting of the District's Board of Directors will be temporarily recessed while the District's Board of Directors retires to an executive session that will not be open to the public. At the conclusion of the executive session, the Board may reconvene the Regular Meeting to consider and decide these matters during a public meeting or defer the decision to a later date.
