Ironwood Drive, Apache Junction, Arizona to discuss and possibly take legal action on the following agenda items. Members of the District’s Board of Directors may attend either in person or by telephone.

Request for authorization and approval for the District to consent to a Third Amendment to the amended and restated District Development, Financing Participation, Waiver, and Intergovernmental Agreement, by and between the City of Apache Junction, the Superstition Vistas Community Facilities District No. 2, Brookfield Communities US Holdings LLC, North America Sekisui House, LLC, and Brookfield ASLD 8500 LLC, which is amended to assign the indemnification obligations under that Agreement, in substantially the form presented at this meeting.

Request for authorization and approval for the District to consent to a First Amendment to the amended and restated District Development, Financing Participation, Waiver, and Intergovernmental Agreement, by and between the City of Apache Junction, the Superstition Vistas Community Facilities District No. 1 and D.R. Horton, Inc, which is amended to assign the indemnification obligations under that Agreement, in substantially the form presented at this meeting.
